


Power Cable Harness Installation



Loosen and detach battery terminals with a 10mm open end wrench (2 places). Loosen and detach battery retention bracket using 10 mm deep well socket wrench (2 places).

Remove battery retention bracket and battery.




Locate <u>Black</u> 4-pin connector taped behind left headlight as shown in illustration or underneath left headlight.


Remove tape to access connector.

Remove male (unwired) half of connector and discard.




Install accessory power cable harness by attaching white connectors.



Route convolute around battery area and behind battery ground cable. Ring terminal and fuse assembly should be near positive (red) battery terminal.

Secure convolute to surrounding wiring using supplied ties (3 places).




Install ring terminal to positive lead using nut on battery post connector.




Converter Module Harness Installation




Remove tire jack and tools located in compartment on right side of cargo area.

Locate white 10-pin electrical connector by removing plastic tray top of the right side interior wheel housing.






Route converter module harness behind tire jack mounting bracket.




Attach converter module to vehicle harness using white 10-pin connectors.

Use 10 mm socket to secure ground wire eyelet to vehicle body using supplied bolt and lock washer.






4-Way Flat with Grommet Harness Installation



Elevate vehicle on a lift.


Disconnect muffler from exhaust pipe.







4-Way Flat with Grommet Harness Installation - Continued




On passenger side wheel well, loosen push pin fasteners (4 places) at lower wheel well liner using Phillips head driver.

Remove push pins and lower wheel well liner. Set aside to be reinstalled.




Detach lower portion of rear fascia by sliding out attachment



Locate opening in body panel behind the rear fascia.

Remove and discard rubber grommet.

Note: The grommet is a 35mm rubber grommet.




Route 4-pin connector into vehicle through the opening.

Insert harness grommet into panel hole and secure around

Reassemble lower fascia tabs and reinstall wheel liner with saved push pins.





Final Installation and Reassembly




Connect to module harness using white 4-pin connectors.



Secure converter module to inside of body panel with foam tape on back of converter.


Wrap foam on white 4-pin connectors

Return and secure jack and tool pouch.




Replace cover on jack compartment.

Reinstall plastic tray.



Replace battery and secure battery bracket.

Reattach battery terminals.



Replace battery terminal cover.

Locate fuse assembly at notch in cover.
