




*Hook fastener is attached to the position shown by the broken line at the back of the mat.


■ PRECAUTIONS

· Be sure to apply the parking brake securely. Remove the ignition key from the key cylinder.

INSTALLATION PROCEDURES

A. INSTALLING THE FRONT FLOOR MATS





- 1) Slide the driver's and front passenger's seats to their rearmost positions.
- 2) For the front passenger's floor mat, position the mat properly to fit the shape of the floor.
- 3) For the driver's floor mat, fit the two mounting holes of the floor mat on the fixing hooks as shown and position the mat properly to fit the shape of the floor.

Warning -


If the movement of the pedals is obstructed by the floor mat (or some other thing) during driving, it may result in a fatal accident.

To prevent this:

- Always secure the floor mat with the hooks on the floor.
- Never place this floor mat on top of or under another floor mat.

B. INSTALLING THE REAR FLOOR MATS



- 1) Slide the driver's and front passenger's seats to their foremost positions.
- 2) Position the rear floor mats properly to fit the shape of the floor. Fix each mat with hook fastener at the back.

CARE AND HANDLING

- · When removing the driver's floor mat, be careful not to damage the hooks on the floor.
- The floor mats are not resistible to oil products such as kerosene. Take care that the mats do not contact them.

Material...Surface: PP
Back side: SBS

• To clean the mats, use lukewarm water or properly diluted neutral detergent.
