



# **■ PRECAUTIONS**


- Perform the work in a well-ventilated space away from flames.
- Be sure to apply the parking brake securely. Remove the ignition key from the key cylinder.
- The drawings in the Installation Procedures depict the installation of the left side parts. Install the right side parts in the same manner.

# **INSTALLATION PROCEDURES**

# A. INSTALLING THE FRONT MUD-GUARD







1) Remove the two splash shield mounting clips on the inside of the front wheelhouse.



# **Note**

Turn the front wheel to face the leftmost position to facilitate the work (rightmost position when working on the right side).

2) Clean and degrease the front mudguard mounting position using isopropyl alcohol or degreaser.




# Caution •

Never use organic solvent such as thinner, benzine, gasoline, etc.

3) Pull the splash shield forward and install the two grommets ② over the clip holes as shown in the drawing.

4) Insert the clip on the front mudguard ① into the square hole at the bottom of the vehicle.



5) Loosely tighten the tapping screws ③. Adjust the position of the front mudguard ① so that there is no clearance between the mudguard ① and the body and then tighten the tapping screws ③ securely.

#### **B. CHECKING AFTER INSTALLATION**

- · Check that the screws are tightened securely. Retighten as necessary.
- Check that there is no clearance between the front mudguard and the body.

# **CARE AND HANDLING**

- To clean the product, wipe with a soft material, such as sponge or chamois leather.
- Do not use any hard material for cleaning such as a scrubbing brush. It could scratch the surface.
- Do not use wax with compound. It could damage the surface.
- Take care to prevent contact with gasoline, kerosene, brake fluid, engine oil, grease, paint thinner, sulfuric
  acid (battery electrolyte) and wax remover that could cause discoloration, staining and cracking. Should any
  of them contact the surface, remove the substance immediately by wiping with a soft cloth or chamois leather
  moistened with a mild detergent, then wash the surface completely with water.
