

① Door mirror cover: 2 (left and right, 1 each)





■ PRECAUTIONS


- Be sure to apply the parking brake securely. Remove the ignition key from the key cylinder.
- The illustrations in the Installation Procedures depict the installation of the left side part. Install the other parts in the same manner.

INSTALLATION PROCEDURES

A. REMOVING THE MIRROR







- 1) Attach the masking tape on the mirror body as shown in the drawing to protect the mirror body from scratches.
- 2) Push the upper side of the mirror to make the mirror face upward.
- 3) Confirm the position of the slot between the mirror and the pivot plate using a flashlight.
- 4) Insert a flat blade screwdriver into the slot confirmed in step 3) (between the mirror and the pivot plate) as shown in the drawing.
- 5) Turn the screwdriver to pry up the mirror and disengage the two hooks one by one.

⚠ Caution

- If it is cold, heat the hooks and their surroundings up to 20°C before the work to prevent the hooks from breakage.
- Be careful not to break the hooks. A mirror with a broken hook may fall off.
- 6) After disengaging the two hooks, push the lower part of the pivot plate with the screwdriver to turn only the pivot plate downward.
- 7) Pull the mirror downward (in arrow direction) and remove it.


Caution

- Do not pull the mirror forcibly as it may damage the actuator, resulting in inoperative mirror.
- Do not disconnect the heater harness (if the mirror is a heated mirror).

B. REMOVING THE STANDARD MIRROR COVER

★: Hook ▲: Hook




1) Release the five hooks at the periphery of the cover one by one. Then release the remaining two hooks and remove the standard mirror cover.

∕!\ Caution

Be careful not to break the hooks during removal of the mirror cover. If any of them is broken, be sure to remove the broken piece as it may be a cause of noise.

C. INSTALLING THE DOOR MIRROR **COVER**





- 1) Fit the forward sides of the door mirror cover ① to the mirror body as shown in the drawing.
- 2) Holding the whole body of the door mirror cover ① by both hands, engage the hooks and set the door mirror cover ① in position.



Caution

- Make the clearance between the door mirror cover 1 and the mirror body
- Check that the entire edge of the door mirror cover 1 fits correctly into the mirror body as shown.








Check the seven hook positions before installation. After installation, tap the mirror cover at the hook positions to check that the hooks are firmly engaged in the mirror


D. INSTALLING THE MIRROR



1) Push the lower part of the pivot plate and face it downward.



2) Engage the upper hooks on the backside of the mirror with the catches on the pivot plate.



3) Press the two hook positions on the bottom part of the mirror as shown in the drawing and engage the hooks firmly.

Caution

Apply finger pressures to the area near the hooks. Pushing elsewhere could break the mirror.

E. CHECKING AFTER INSTALLATION

• Check that the mirror is secured firmly with the hooks.

CARE AND HANDLING

- To clean the product, wipe with a soft material such as sponge or chamois leather.
- Do not use any hard material for cleaning such as a scrubbing brush, as it could scratch the surface.
- Do not use wax with compound, as it could damage the surface.
- Take care to prevent contact with gasoline, kerosene, brake fluid, engine oil, grease, paint thinner, sulfuric
 acid (battery electrolyte) and wax remover that could cause discoloration, staining and cracking. Should any
 of them contact the surface, remove the substance immediately by wiping with a soft cloth or chamois leather
 moistened with mild detergent, then wash the surface thoroughly with water.
