1. Description:

According to the design change, the password erasing procedure for the hands-free-ECU has been established in the applicable Workshop Manual. This Service Bulletin contains the new procedure.

C-317 ETACS-ECU connector, and repair if necessary.


Q: Is the check result normal?

YES : Replace the hands-free-ECU. The system should communicate with the hands-free-ECU normally.

NO: Repair the wiring harness.



ERASE THE PASSWORD



The 4-digit password set by security function can be erased by operating the hang-up switch.

- Turn the ignition switch to the "ON" or "ACC" position, and check if the audio unit or the audio visual navigation unit is activated.
- Check that the hands free cellular phone system is not in voice recognition mode.
- Press and hold the hang-up switch for approximately 2 seconds (1.5 seconds or more).
- Within approximately 10 seconds after performing step 3, press and hold the hang-up switch for approximately 2 seconds (1.5 seconds or more) twice again.

NOTE: Even if the password is erased, guidance such as voice guide is not provided.

After the operation, check if the lock with the password is unlocked. If the lock is not unlocked, repeat from step 2.
